us into looking at our transport needs. We have a young staff who tend to live in the city and use public transport and we've got limited car parking available.

"I hope that using WhizzGo cars means we can avoid buying pool cars, and it is something the staff are keen on as well. Working in highways, we do a lot of green travel plans. Using WhizzGo cars reinforces our environmental message and emphasises that we believe in what we are saying.

"The flexibility of getting a car for a minimum of an hour is very convenient for spur of the moment meetings; if a client phones up and wants to meet on site you can pick up a car very quickly."
