Transport Strategy

This leaflet outlines the various travel options available to you when visiting the Calderdale Royal Hospital and Huddersfield Royal Infirmary sites.

The Trust wishes to make your visit as straightforward as possible and hopes that the information provided is useful to you when planning your journey.

Included in the leaflet are telephone numbers and website addresses to use if you need further information.

The Trust must ensure that access for essential clinical services is maintained to hospital sites at all times. It is also a priority to make sure that those with mobility difficulties can easily use our facilities.

The increasing reliance on the car in recent years, especially for short journeys, has unfortunately given rise to increased congestion, more road traffic accidents as well as an increase in cases of asthma and other respiratory diseases resulting from high levels of air pollution. As a healthcare organisation we must try and do all we can to help reduce emissions whilst encouraging people to take more exercise by leaving their cars at home when they can.

To help us achieve this we are working closely with our healthcare partners, as well as the Metropolitan Borough Councils of Calderdale and Kirklees and Metro. We are constantly striving to improve facilities and assist those who are able to make use of alternatives to the car; such as cycling, walking, public transport and car sharing.

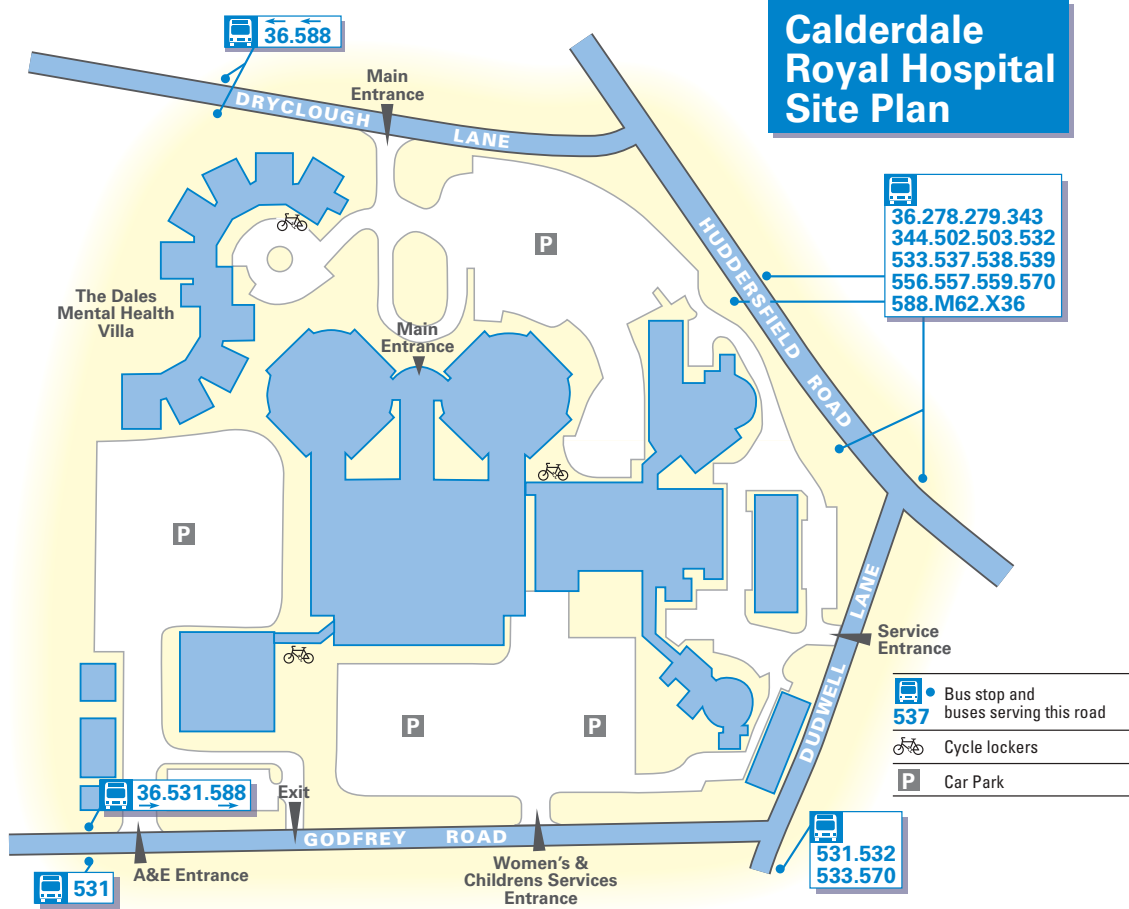

Halifax Rail Station

Halifax Railway Station is approximately 2 miles from the Calderdale Royal Hospital.

From Halifax Railway Station catch bus number 531 in Horton Street, just 2 minutes walk away, every 30 minutes. Or take a walk to Halifax Bus Station, approximately 8 minutes away.

Huddersfield Rail Station

Huddersfield Railway Station is approximately 3 miles from the Huddersfield Royal Infirmary.

From just outside of Huddersfield Railway Station catch bus number 371, 372 that runs every 10 minutes. Or walk to Huddersfield Bus Station, less than 5 minutes away, for more bus options.

By Cycle

Car Parking

A 'pay and display' car park system operates at both the Calderdale Royal Hospital and the Huddersfield Royal Infirmary with patients and visitors paying to park in specially designated car parks.

Find space first, and then obtain ticket from a machine. Display inside windscreen.

If you choose to come by car, please remember to bring change for the car park ticket machines.

Charges apply from 8:00am to 8:00pm.

Up to 4 hours £2.50

4 Plus hours £5.00

Registered Disabled

If you are a registered disabled badge holder display your valid badge in your windscreen and you may park free of charge. There are a number of parking spaces for those who are registered disabled, close to the hospital entrances.

An intercom system is in operation at the Calderdale Royal Hospital for drivers with disabilities requiring assistance.

Car Park Security

The car parks are covered by CCTV cameras 24 hours a day and are regularly patrolled by security guards. The Trust will endeavour to ensure the safety of vehicles parked on site however it is unable to accept any liability for damage to or loss from vehicles using the car park.

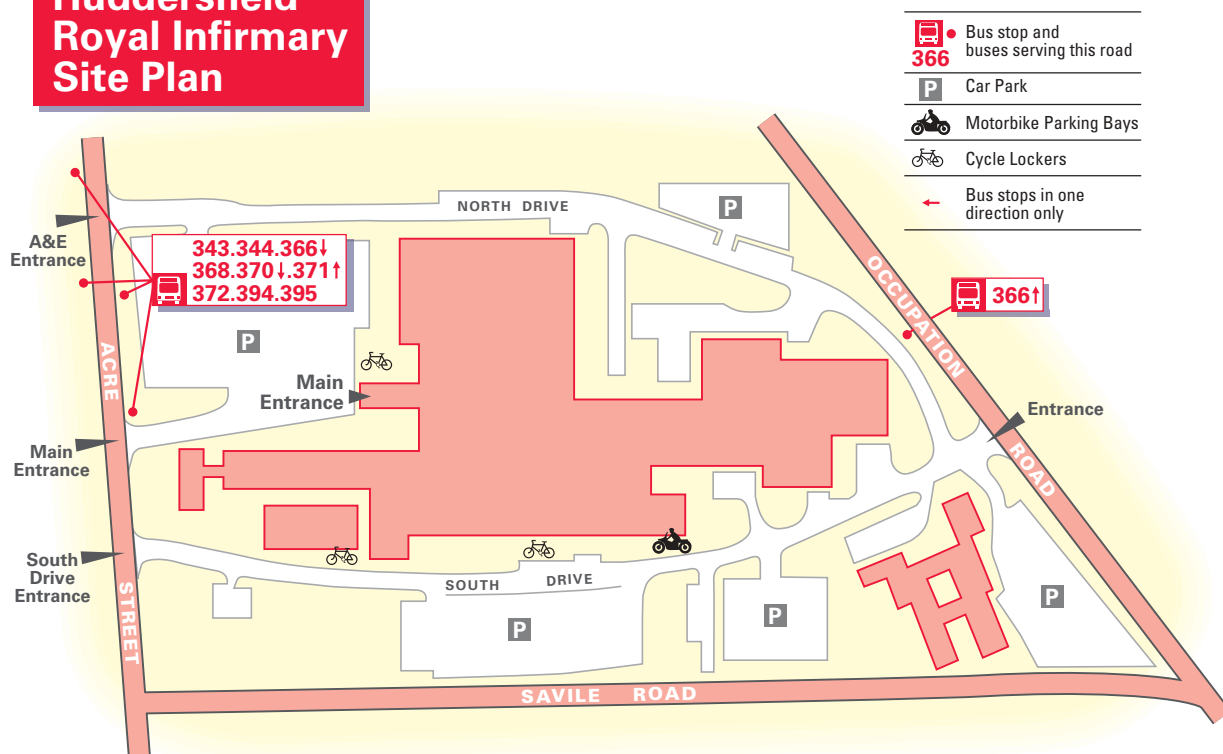
